## Instructions

To apply for the Income-Based Repayment plan, complete the appropriate sections of the following application form and include all required documentation.

**Note:** FFEL Program loans are eligible for the Income-Based Repayment (IBR) Plan only.

## **Married Borrowers Who File Taxes Jointly**

If you file jointly and your spouse has eligible loans in repayment that you would like to take into consideration to determine your monthly payment, please have your spouse complete the following steps:

- 1. Log in at **studentaid.gov**.
- 2. Select your name at the top of the screen to view the dropdown menu.
- 3. Select "Settings."
- 4. Select "Authorizations."
- 5. Enter the Aspire Servicing Center<sup>SM</sup> organization code 700196 and select "Grant Access."

## **Spousal Consolidation Loans**

If you have a spousal consolidation loan, each borrower must complete a separate application.
